HIGH POINTS**

CHAMPIONSHIPS

To qualify for an overall championship horse and rider must successfully complete an official or associate test at the same level on both days, + 1 freestyle in that level. Freestyle placings will not count in championship (other than FEI) but must be ridden. If contesting two consecutive championships, the freestyle test must be ridden at the higher level. Most freestyles will be ridden on Saturday.
